During the course, students prepare a team security analysis utilizing the acquired analytical tools.

Lecture topics:

- Concept of Security and development of security arrangements
- Security analysis terminology and risk assessment matrices
- Conflict and military analysis
- Open-source intelligence and information analysis
- Energy Security network analysis
- Cyber Security vulnerability analysis
- Information Warfare disinformation analysis

Participating students will also earn academic credit at MSU for their participation in these European studies. MSU course registration is required in DSS 796 to participate in either opportunity in addition to Masaryk program registration.
