Jana Honkova, held the distinct honor of guest lecturing at the prestigious NATO School in Oberammergau, Germany. While there Jana lent her expertise to the school on a variety of subjects, including Russia's nuclear, ballistic missile defense, and military space capabilities. She also led a discussion on military thinking in a Nuclear Policy Course that was specifically and uniquely designed for senior military and civilian staff, and moderated a discussion on the future of NATO's nuclear deterrent.

Jana's proficient accomplishments include her time as a George C. Marshall Institute Research Associate. Throughout her time as a Research Associate, Jana was published multiple times and earned the privilege of representing the Institute at multiple international events. These events include the Harvard Asia Conference, 2013 in Dubai, UAE and the Center for Strategic and International Studies' Project on Nuclear Issues (PONI) 2013 Spring Conference held in Utah, USA.
